Field Trauma Care for Police Officers

Instructor: Lt. Scott Oldham- featured author in *Law and Order* and *Tactical Response*

This 8 hour course looks at a number of case studies to determine how officers have died and what could have been done to save them. This training will explore the survivability rate of traumatic injuries when immediate care is applied in the field prior to EMS intervention.

Officers will leave this hands-on course knowing how to address a life threatening injury to themselves or another officer and the proper application of necessary medical equipment. Officers will understand why it is imperative to have crucial supplies within reach at all times.

Topics Covered:

Body Composition

-What within the body is critical to life, and what you CAN survive

Wound Ballistics

- A look at what differing calibers/rounds/projectiles actually do to a body

Tourniquets/Application of Tourniquets

-Comparison of different types of tourniquets and how they are used

Chest Seals/Application of Chest Seals

-Comparison of different types and how they are applied

Wound Packing

- Learning how to pack a wound and then actually doing it using a mock up

Trauma Care Without Medical Supplies

-Learning to improvise with items found in immediate environment

Self Care Scenarios

- Application of care to self

Buddy Care Scenarios

- Administering care to another officer

Low Light Scenarios

- All of the above in limited light
